**SUNDAY, August 18, 2019 Event Schedule**

7:00 A.M. Gates open

7:00-8:30 A.M. Rider CHECK IN/ SIGN UP (AMA CARD REQUIRED)

7:00-8:30 A.M. Rider inspection of Short Course (WALKING ONLY)

**7:30 A.M. Chapel Service (in Pavilion-attendance optional)**

**8:00 A.M. Rider Meeting (at Start/Finish area)**

**HOT LAP STARTING ORDER:**

- Order determined by combination of 2018 TKO final results, results at other Extreme Enduro events and championship points earned in major off-road race series. Top qualified riders start first.

**9:00-10:00 A.M. Hot lap on short course** (1 rider starts every 30 seconds)

- Hot Lap time determines starting order of KNOCKOUT #1. **Rider must complete Hot Lap to start TKO KNOCKOUT Race #1.**

**10:15-12:15 P.M. KNOCKOUT RACE #1 on long course**

- All riders starting in finishing order of hot lap (best first) start 1 rider every 30 seconds.
- Fastest 25 riders move on to KNOCKOUT RACE #2.

**12:15-12:45 P.M. TKO Duel LCQ on Playground course** (If time permits based TKO Race 1 finishing times)

- 26th to 29th fastest compete in TKO Duel LCQ. If one or more of those riders can't or don't want to compete, the next fastest rider(s) present will be invited to take that spot. 4 Riders compete in head-to-head races in pairs. Up to three races for each pair with first rider to win two in each pair moving on to next Duel round (Two pairs in round 1 and final two riders in round 2). The winner moves on to KNOCKOUT Race #2. If there is not enough time to hold the TKO Duel, the 26<sup>th</sup> finisher will be placed in group 5.

**1:00-2:30 P.M. KNOCKOUT RACE #2 on long course**

- Fastest 25 riders from KNOCKOUT RACE #1 will advance into 5 groups of 5 riders. Knockout Duel winner will be placed in group 5 for a total of 26 riders.
- A group will start every two minutes (DEAD ENGINE START!).
- Starting position determined by times in KNOCKOUT RACE 1 (Each of the top 5 riders leading a group of 5). The 6th fastest qualifier is the second seeded rider in group one and so on.
- Top three riders from each group will advance to FINAL KNOCKOUT.

**3:30-4:15 P.M. Final KNOCKOUT** Final 15 riders compete in multi-lap race on the short course (Approximately 35-40 minute race).

- All five winners of TKO 2 on row 1, five second place finishers on row 2 and five third place finishers on row 3.
- DEAD ENGINE START! 30 Minutes plus one lap.
- Awards immediately following the main event on top of the starting tower.
