



Rider Information for Friday and Saturday August 14 & 15, 2020

Hello riders and welcome to the COVID-19 rules of riding the 2020 TKO. We will be following the AMA's Safe to Race guidelines this year, so a few things will be a bit different. **Most importantly, if you are NOT wearing a FULL-FACE helmet, you will need to wear a mask. Please bring one with you.**

PLEASE respect the social distancing signs posted throughout grounds and review the Safe to Race information posted on the TKO website and in the rider information e-mail.

FIRST AND FOREMOST-- Camping is **NO LONGER** a first come/first served basis for this event. RV camping fees are \$40 per night, Tent camping is \$30 per night. If you wish to reserve a site, but have not already done so, you **MUST** register through Eventbrite via the link on the TKO website <https://tennesseeknockoutenduro.com/camping-on-site/>.

If you have reserved a campsite (RV and/or Tent) but not paid, you will need to pay camping (and spectator fees, if you have family/spectators with you) through Eventbrite by going to the link on the TKO website **BEFORE AUGUST 1, 2020!**

If you have not paid your camping fees by midnight on July 31, 2020, your campsite reservation will be deleted. When you pay your camping/spectator fees, a mirror hanger with your name and campsite assignment (along with any spectator wristbands) can be picked up at the WILL CALL gate.

Upon arrival at the Trials Training Center, you will stop and give the gate keeper your name (this is where you will get your spectator wristbands and mirror hanger); as a rider, you will **NOT** be charged a gate fee, however you will need to show your mirror hanger to the next gate person who will direct you to your camp site. If you arrive after the gate is closed, you will need to check in with the security officer who will give you your WILL CALL wristbands and mirror hanger and direct you to your campsite..

If you are bringing spectators **but not camping**, you will need to purchase your spectator tickets on-line via the link above and your spectator wristbands will be waiting for you at the WILL CALL gate. Your family/spectators will be required to wear masks throughout the weekend.

If you are competing in TKO but are not camping, you will need to get a yellow parking permit at the gate (no charge) and will be directed to park in the yellow parking area on site.

MASKS AND WRISTBANDS MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES DURING THE WEEKEND.

There will be two releases that you will need to print out.



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The first is the AMA Release and Waiver of Liability that you typically sign when attending any AMA sanctioned event. Please print out this page and have everyone in your vehicle (including you) sign the release and give to the gate attendant.

The second is the new COVID-19 Release, a/k/a Communicable disease exposure and infection assumption of risk, hold harmless, release, waiver of liability and indemnity agreement. Please print this form out, sign and bring with you to check in to give to the TKO administration.

Helmets are required to be worn any time that you are riding a motorcycle! If you are NOT on a motorcycle you are required to wear a mask!!

SILENCERS ARE REQUIRED TO COMPETE

The TKO is an AMA Grand National Championship sanctioned event and does not allow spectator vehicles during the event. If you have been “Knocked Out” of competition or decide not to compete in the next race, you then become a spectator. **THERE ARE NO SPECTATOR MOTORCYCLES, ATVS, 4 WHEELERS, UTVs/SXS ALLOWED WHILE SPECTATING.** If you are caught riding and are NOT competing in a current race, security will escort you to your pit area to park your bike; if you have to be asked a second time to park your bike, you will be escorted off the property.

Please obey the posted **5 mile per hour** speed signs located around the pit areas.

As a rider, you will need to check in at the **GREEN** shop to receive your rider packet (wearing a mask). **We will be taking your temperature before you receive your rider packet, so if you feel sick or have been sick-STAY HOME.**

ONLY riders (and one parent of minor riders) need to come to rider check in. YOU MUST BE WEARING A MASK TO CHECK IN! BRING YOUR OWN PEN, PLEASE.

In the rider packet, you will find your front number plate sticker; please put the number plate sticker on your **front number plate**. Please remove all non-TKO associated numbers/number plates from your bike.

When you arrive at the Start, the start crew will be checking for goggles, long sleeve shirts and pants, functioning silencer and whether you are on “trials equipped” motorcycle, etc. Please help accommodate these volunteer personnel. There will be a **DEAD ENGINE START.** Remember that trials motorcycles and trials tires are welcome to participate in Saturday’s competition, however, trials motorcycles and motorcycles with trials tires will **NOT** be eligible for the AMA Grand National Championship or advance into the Sunday competition.



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Kenda Equilibrium and IbeX tires ARE allowed as they are not considered Trials tires.

On Friday, prior to the Prologue, riders will be allowed to preview the Prologue course. Please see the Supplemental Rules for the Prologue schedule and information.

There will be a riders meeting at 8:00, Saturday morning (CDT) at the start/finish area; please plan to attend this meeting!

NOTE: THE APPROXIMATELY 20 MILE COURSE IS MARKED WITH ORANGE SRT ARROWS AND YELLOW MOOSE RIBBON.

THERE IS NO OUTSIDE ASSISTANCE ALLOWED DURING ANY RACING AT THE TKO. RIDERS ACTIVELY COMPETING IN THE CURRENT RACE CAN HELP OTHER RIDERS IN THAT RACE.

The First Knockout race will begin at 9:00 a.m. CDT, with Row 1 leaving the Start at 9:01, Row 2 at 9:02 and so on. Riders will line up according to their position based on the Prologue results with six riders per row. Any riders NOT riding in the Prologue will line up behind the Prologue riders based on their registration placement. A list of rider row assignments will be posted at scoring and TKO administration check in area.

Riders will have a 2 hour and 30-minute time limit to finish 1 lap on the approximately 20-mile-long course (each rider has 2 hours and 30 minutes from **their start time**). The fastest **finishing** riders (up to 200 finishers) within the time limit from the TKO race #1 will advance to the TKO race #2. **Finishing** riders **within the time limit** but NOT advancing into TKO race #2 will receive a Bronze medallion.

The TKO race #2 will start at 1:00 p.m. with Row 1 leaving at 1:01, Row 2 at 1:02 and so on.

Riders will be lined up as follows, 6 riders to a row:

Prequalified riders from the six AMA qualifying races (King of the Motos, Tough Like Rorr, Bad Medicine at Fallen Timbers, Mad Moose, Battle of the Goats and the 2020 TKO 1), line up based on their Prologue race time; prequalified riders that did not compete in the prologue will line up behind the riders that competed in the prologue with starting order based on their AMA regional qualifier position.

Finishers (up to the top 200) from 2020 TKO 1 will line up next in order based on the race one results (6 riders to a row).

The Second Knockout race will consist of one lap on an approximately 20-mile-long course with **at least** four (4) skills areas added. Riders will have a 2-hour time limit to complete the course.



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The fastest 50 finishers within the time limit will receive a Gold medallion. The 30 fastest finishers on **NON-Trials equipped motorcycles** will advance to Sunday's Expert Races. Remaining finishers within the time limit in the second race will receive a Silver medallion.

The **Women's** Knockout Qualifier race will be part of the amateur race one with the women riders earning their starting positions among the amateur riders based on their prologue time (Any riders NOT riding in the Prologue will line up behind the Prologue riders based on their registration placement). A list of rider row assignments will be posted at scoring and TKO administration check in area. Riders will have a 2 hour and 30-minute time limit to finish **ONE** lap on the approximately 20-mile course. Finishers will advance to the **WOMEN'S FINAL RACE** on Saturday afternoon at 4:00 p.m.

The **WOMEN'S FINAL RACE** will start at 4:00 p.m. CDT on the women's short course. Starting order will be assigned by fastest finishing order of qualifying race.

Women riders in the final will be competing for a share of the \$2,000.00 purse. The top three women will be invited to compete in the Sunday TKO.

Concessions will be available throughout the event, so please help support our local vendors.
