



Supplemental Rules for Women's Class:

SILENCERS ARE REQUIRED TO COMPETE

NO OUTSIDE ASSISTANCE ALLOWED DURING ANY OF THE 2021 TKO RACES

THERE WILL BE NO HELMET CAMERA ATTACHED TO YOUR HELMET.

Per the AMA Racing Rule Book:

"All helmets must be intact, and no modification may be made to their construction that alters the helmet from the condition it was tested and approved. The helmet is made to provide protection and is not a platform to attach foreign objects. For example, cameras or other accessories are NOT permitted to be attached to the rider's helmet."

You can put your camera on your bike or your body, but **NOT** on your helmet.

RIDERS ON TRIALS MOTORCYCLES AND/OR RIDERS USING TRIALS TIRES WILL NOT QUALIFY FOR WOMEN 'S FINAL RACE

Description:

For 2021, there will be both Amateur-Women and Pro-Women classes. All the women riders can ride the Friday prologue to earn a starting position among the amateur riders. Any riders that do not ride the prologue will be lined up behind the riders that completed a prologue time based on when entries were received. All race times are adjusted for start time.

Amateur Women:

The Amateur women will compete in Saturday race one with the results of that race determining the amateur results. Any amateur women riders that finish within the two-hour and thirty-minute time limit AND within the top 200 overall, will be eligible to move to TKO race two.

Pro Women:

The Pro-Women will compete in race two and this will be the championship deciding race (it will not be a qualifying race like it has been in the past). There will be a \$2,000 purse for the pro women.

The top four women riders will be invited to the Prologue Straight Rhythm event, which will have an additional purse payout. The top four women will also be invited to participate in the Sunday races.
