



Supplemental Rules for ECR eMoto Class:

NO OUTSIDE ASSISTANCE ALLOWED DURING ANY TKO RACES

ECR eMoto (Electric Motorcycle) Class

- The ECR eMoto class will be an open format that will allow electric motorcycles of all power levels with a minimum rear wheel size of 16 inches. Trials style motorcycles and Trials tires are allowed for the eMoto class.
- Riders of all skill levels that are 16 years of age and older will be eligible to enter the ECR eMoto class.
- ECR eMoto riders will be given the opportunity to compete in the HOT-LAP qualifying session to earn their starting position in TKO Race #1. Riders that don't ride the HOT-LAP will start behind all eMoto HOT-LAP riders based on your initial registration position.
- The ECR eMoto class will start at 8:30 a.m. before the amateur race 1 riders in rows of six riders (Amateurs start at 9:00 am).
- The ECR eMoto class will be scored separate from the amateur classes and not affect amateur rider qualification to TKO Race 2 or Sunday.
- Riders will compete on a modified amateur race 1 loop that will be approximately 14 miles long. Results based on adjusted time from start to finish of 1 loop.
- The top six ECR eMoto riders that complete loop 1 will be eligible to compete in TKO Race 2 as the last row of six riders.
