**RIDER CHECK IN:** Thursday from 3:00 PM to 6:00 PM and Friday from 8:00 AM-6:00 PM CDT

**FRIDAY HOT-LAP WILL SET RIDER ROW ASSIGNMENTS FOR SATURDAY RACES.** Riders that don't ride the HOT-LAP will start behind all HOT-LAP riders based on their initial registration position.

**RIDERS MUST CHECK IN TO GET YOUR RIDER PACKET AND TRANSPONDER PRIOR TO RIDING THE HOT-LAP**

### ECR eMoto (Electric Motorcycle) Class

- The ECR eMoto class is an open format that will allow electric motorcycles of all power levels with a minimum rear wheel size of 16 inches. Trials style motorcycles and Trials tires are allowed for the eMoto class.
- Riders of all skill levels that are 16 years of age and older will be eligible to enter the ECR eMoto class.
- The ECR eMoto racers will compete in a four-round format.
  - ECR eMoto riders will be given the opportunity to compete in the Friday HOT-LAP qualifying session to earn their starting position in TKO Race #1. Riders that don't ride the HOT-LAP will start behind all eMoto HOT-LAP riders based on their initial registration position.
  - Saturday morning, the ECR eMoto Riders will compete in a qualification race on the amateur "long course" that will be approximately 10 to 14 miles long. The top ten finishers qualify for the Sunday ECR eMoto final race.
    - On Saturday, the ECR eMoto class will start at 8:30 AM before the amateur race 1 riders in rows of six riders (Amateurs start at 9:00 am).
    - The ECR eMoto class will be scored separate from the amateur classes and not affect amateur rider qualification to TKO Race 2 or Sunday.
    - The eleventh to fourteenth place ECR eMoto finishers from the Saturday race one will qualify for a straight rhythm LCQ on Saturday afternoon. The riders will compete in head-to-head knockout format with the winner earning the eleventh and final spot in the Sunday LCQ.
  - On Sunday, the eleven ECR eMoto main event qualifiers from Saturday will compete in the championship deciding final race (Only the eleven qualified riders are eligible to race on Sunday. If one of those qualified riders decides to not race, we will not "move up" riders that did not qualify). This race will take place on the Sunday pro long course (approximately 10 to 14 miles). The ECR eMoto racers will take off in thirty-second intervals based on the race one results after the last of the pro riders starts their morning loop one.
  - The ECR eMoto riders will be eligible to qualify for the pro top thirty based on their adjusted time if they are not using a Trials tire. So, an ECR eMoto rider could qualify for the Sunday KNOCKOUT RACE #2 and then if they finish in the top four in their KNOCKOUT RACE #2 group, they could qualify for the Sunday pro FINAL KNOCKOUT race.
